

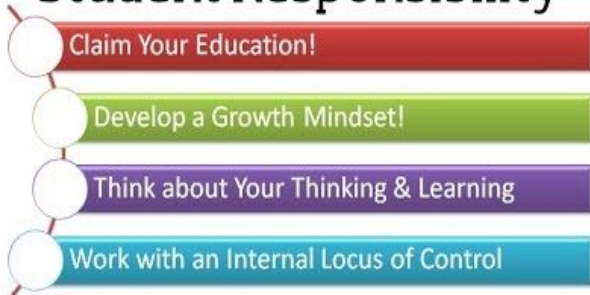
Responsibilities
