- ? = QUESTION...and actually **WRITE** the question you have using correct punctuation.
- (\_\_\_\_\_) = CONNECTION...and actually <u>WRITE</u> how you personally connect to the passage (complete sentence).
- ! = WOW...this just blew me away...amazing facts or details OR utter disbelief.
- **VZ** = VISUALIZE...created a mental picture of what was being said.
- \* = RESEARCH...further research is needed for me to understand this.
- I = INFER...<u>WRITE</u> what you conclude from evidence and reasoning (not explicitly stated) in a complete sentence.
- = = CLUE...leads to other/in-depth understanding (be able to defend this with examples/evidence).
